



PRIVACY POLICY*

What is the Purpose of this Privacy Policy?

Intermedia created this Privacy Policy to demonstrate our firm commitment to the privacy of our customers, private label resellers and affiliates. This Privacy Policy sets forth our practices regarding the gathering and dissemination of Information (as defined below).

How does Intermedia define “Information” under this Policy?

In this Privacy Policy, “Information” means the following:

- information collected from you through access to or use of Intermedia’s websites; and
- if you are a current customer, private label reseller or affiliate of Intermedia,
 - your Data, if and as such term is defined in your Master Service Agreement, Private Label Reseller Agreement, Affiliate Agreement or other agreement with Intermedia (the “Agreement”);
 - if your Agreement does not define the term “Data”, any information collected through your and your users’ access to or use of our platform or services (the “Services”), including as the term “Services” is defined in the Agreement.

If you have an Agreement with Intermedia, (i) any conflict or inconsistency between this Privacy Policy and Intermedia’s confidentiality obligations to you under the Agreement shall be resolved in favor of the Agreement and (ii) any reference to “you” in this Privacy Policy shall also refer to any individual or entity using Services under your account with Intermedia.

By visiting our websites or using our Services, you accept and consent to the practices set forth in this Privacy Policy on behalf of you and your users.

What is the Scope of this Policy?

This Privacy Policy only covers Information collected by Intermedia. Intermedia's websites may, from time to time, contain links to third party websites. If you follow a link to any of these websites, please note that these websites have their own privacy policies and that Intermedia does not accept any responsibility or liability for these policies. Please check these policies before you submit any data to these websites.

What are Intermedia’s Guidelines Regarding Children?

Intermedia requires that all account holders be 18 years of age or older. In addition, our websites and Services are not designed for or directed to children under the age of 13, and Intermedia will not intentionally collect or maintain data about any person under the age of 13. How Does Intermedia Use Cookies?

We use cookies to retain your session states when you are logged into our administrative control panels. You may opt out of the use of cookies by turning them off in your web browser. However, the use of cookies is necessary for the use of the administrative control panels and other Services. Please note that any of our advertisers also may use cookies, over which we have no control.

What about My Use of Intermedia Forums?

Intermedia may make chat rooms, forums, message boards, news groups and similar media, including social media, available to you. Please remember that any Information that is disclosed in these areas may become public and you should exercise caution when deciding to disclose any Information in any of these areas.

What Kind of Information Does Intermedia Collect?

Intermedia may collect the following Information about you:

- personal and non-personal information that you voluntarily provide when using our websites or Services, including contact information (such as name, address, email address and telephone number), financial information and other information;
- any Data required to provide the Services to you, including the content of e-mail and other material you use in connection with the Services;
- information collected during your visits to our websites or your use of our Services, including, but not limited to, traffic data, location data, IP address, your computer's operating system and browser type, weblogs and other communication and technical data; and
- information about your general Internet usage collected by using a cookie file which is typically stored on the hard drive of your computer. Please see the "Cookies" section below for a further explanation.

How Does Intermedia Use, Store and Retain Information?

Intermedia may use, store and retain Information in the following ways:

- to provide you with information regarding the status of your account, to determine your tax status, and to bill you for our Services;
- to provide you with information and Services that you request from Intermedia and to carry out Intermedia's obligations arising from any agreement entered into between you and Intermedia, including the Agreement;
- to administer, test, analyze and improve Intermedia's Services and to facilitate marketing, including providing you with information about available Services and related products and services;
- to gather broad demographic and statistical information and to report aggregate information to Intermedia's advertisers and partners; and
- to notify you about changes to the Services.

If you are an existing customer, unless you ask Intermedia to provide you with additional marketing information we will only contact you by electronic means (e-mail or by posting to your account with Intermedia).

We are committed to keeping Information no longer than necessary to achieve the purpose for which it was collected. However, some Information, including account and log information, may be retained indefinitely. Such Information shall continue to be subject to Intermedia's Privacy Policy after any termination of your account with Intermedia.

How Does Intermedia Access, Release and Disseminate Information?

Intermedia will release your Information as is reasonably necessary for the provision of Services. This includes, but is not limited to:

- provision of financial information to organizations such as VeriSign, PaymenTech, Signio CyberCash and similar organizations for billing purposes;
- provision of contact, usage related Information to our service and license providers for the purpose of licensing compliance, licensing usage calculation, billing and support purposes;
- provision of Data and other Information to vendors and contractors providing services in support of Intermedia's provision of Services to you; and
- transfer Information to apply for and use separate third-party services and licenses through Intermedia. The will be subject to the privacy policy and other related terms of the third-party and not this Privacy Policy one such Information is released.

In addition, Intermedia may access and release your Information without notice or consent under the following circumstances:

- In response to subpoenas, warrants, government inquiries, court orders, or legal process, or to establish or exercise our rights to defend against legal claims, as determined by Intermedia in each case;
- If we believe it is necessary to investigate, prevent, or take action regarding illegal activities, suspected fraud, safety of person or property, violation of our policies, or as otherwise required by law (this includes exchanging information with other companies and organisations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction); and
- If Intermedia, any of its websites or Services or a related asset or line of business is acquired by, transferred to, or merged with another company.

What if I am Located within the European Economic Area?

If you are located within the European Economic Area ("EEA"), your Information may be transferred outside the EEA for processing. These countries may not have similar data protection laws to the EEA. If Intermedia transfers your Information outside of the EEA in this way, it will take steps to ensure that your privacy rights continue to be protected. In addition, if you access our websites or Services while you are outside of the EEA, your Information may be transferred outside of the EEA in order to provide you with such access. Intermedia adheres to the European Safe Harbor principles as set forth by the United States Department of Commerce regarding the collection, use, and retention of personally identifiable information collected from citizens of the European Union. Is My Information Secure?

Intermedia takes steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your Information is treated securely and in accordance with this Privacy Policy and requires its suppliers to do the same. Intermedia has security measures in place to help protect against the loss, misuse, or alteration of the Information under Intermedia's control. Your contact and financial information is submitted via a secure (HTTPS) connection and stored in the Intermedia database protected by a firewall. Any payment transactions will be encrypted using SSL technology.

Although Intermedia uses reasonable efforts to protect your Information, transmission via the Internet is not completely secure. Therefore Intermedia cannot guarantee the security of your Information transmitted using our websites or Services and any transmission is at your own risk.

How Do I Contact Intermedia, Including to Terminate or Opt-Out?

You have the right to request that Intermedia not contact you or use your Information for purposes which are not reasonably necessary for the administration of our websites and/or the provision of Services. In addition, certain Information may be required in order to use our websites or Services; as such, the only practicable method to opt out of providing Information in connection with the use of those websites or Services would be to refrain from subscribing to or using those websites or Services.
